



Call to Convene Jefferson County Republican Party PRECINCT OFFICER ELECTIONS

What/Why- Republican voters in each precinct meet to elect a Captain, a Co-Captain and a Youth Captain (40 years of age or younger when elected). The elections are a part of the reorganization of Republican National Committee (RNC) and the Republican Party of Kentucky (JCRP) which occurs every 4 years. The purpose is to strengthen our grassroots efforts so we can elect Republican candidates to offices from the Presidency to Metro Council. Newcomers as well as politically experienced people are welcomed and encouraged to attend. If you are interested in serving on the JCRP Executive Committee as an At-Large member, please complete and return the application on our website by March 1, 2012.

When/Where- Elections will be held on Saturday, March 3rd at Jefferson County Republican Party Headquarters located at 4710 Champions Trace Suite 104, Louisville, KY 40218. A map is located on our website: www.louisvillegop.com. Registration will begin 30 minutes prior to each scheduled Legislative District meeting beginning at 8:30 AM.

If you do not know in which legislative district (LD) you reside, you can enter your residential address on this website created by LOJIC: <http://ags2.lojic.org/WhereDoIVote/>. The letter in the precinct number signifies which LD; you can match it to the letter in the table above. Please arrive a half-hour prior to the meeting to facilitate the registration process.

Who/What To Bring- To participate, you must be a Registered Republican voter in Jefferson County as of October 10, 2011 (i.e. eligible Republican voter in previous General Election). You must show a government issued photo ID. If you have moved from one precinct to another since Oct. 10, you must bring proof of address (current driver's license, utility bill, etc.). We will then verify that with the registration information available through the Secretary of State's website. We are requesting a voluntary \$5.00 donation per registrant to help defray the expenses of reorganization.

What Are The Duties Of Precinct Officers? Precinct officers are expected to support the Republican Party and to volunteer for Republican candidates. Precinct officers are the first level of grassroots volunteerism that the party needs to campaign effectively and win elections. Volunteering in our local Victory Office and/or with our 72-hour Campaign is appreciated. Effective volunteer efforts include networking with voters, recruiting other volunteers, distributing yard signs, encouraging new residents to register to vote, and contacting Republican voters to remind them to vote. As elected leaders, precinct officers may not volunteer for, publicly support, sign ballot petitions for, or contribute financially to a non-Republican in a partisan election with a Republican candidate.
